NO. 6 HULKS' BOAT RACE.

Entries to be posted on Flagship.

DIRECTIONS.

COURSE No. 1.

For First-class Yachts only. From Flagship at Lowry Bay with S. wind, starting across an imaginary line between the Flagship and Mr. Pearce's house; thence to and round Koro Koro Buoy, leaving same on port hand; thence to and round Pinnacle Rock Buoy, leaving same on port hand, and back to Flagship, keeping on eastern side of Somes' Island and west of Hope Shoal Buoy. Once round. Distance, 14 knots. N.B.—Reverse course with N. wind.

COURSE No 2.

From Flagship at Lowry Bay with S. wind, starting across an imaginary line between Flagship and Mr. Pearce's house; thence to and round Koro Koro Buoy, leaving same on port hand; thence to and round Hope Shoal Buoy, leaving same on port hand; thence to Flagship, keeping on eastern side of Somes' Island. Once round. Distance, 10½ knots. N.B.—Reverse course if N. wind.

STARTING OF SECOND RACES.

If all the boats in the first race of any class are not across the finishing line before the starting time of the second race, it shall be optional for the sub-committee of the day to start or postpone the race.

In the event of a shift in the wind, boats will keep the course on which they start.

For all events three to start or no second prize, subject to Rule 28.

In all races boats to cross finishing line not later than 7 p.m.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR STARTING.

For each race Blue Peter will be hoisted and gun fired as a time signal five minutes before starting time of first boat, and Blue Peter will be lowered when five minutes have expired. Each Yacht will be allotted a flag, to be hoisted on Flagship five minutes before starting time of such yacht; when time is up her flag will be lowered as a signal to start. Should, however, any yacht be over the starting line before the time her flag will be kept up as a recall signal, and will be lowered as a signal to start after such yacht has recrossed the starting line.

Letter N of the Commercial Code, hoisted on Thorndon Yacht Club Shed, shall be the signal that all races have been postponed.

Handicaps for first race for Third Class Yachts will be declared at 9 a.m., and Handicaps for all classes second race will be declared at 1.45 p.m.

All handicaps will be posted on Flagship, and a copy handed to starter.
