Vega. Built Wengarae. ^{Oram} Owned Hadfield Smith - Jack Barker when Commodore
Went to Makara. RPNYC.

Viking (Black) Very much an Evans Bay Boat Keleh a clipper bow.
owned Cyril Headland. - Freyberg Family (Sir Bernard)
C Bailey senior. (I think) Nice photo available.

Wanderer. Possibly a Lehouquet boat. Owned for many years
by Godsift. Kenepuru Sound. Latter Chris Harris.

White Heather a Bailey & Lowe product. went to Tahiti in 30s.

Wyle. Built E Bailey in BH. Design Prof Scott. Alan Martin
owned in late 40s Built for Photo L/S Carter.

Yvonne. While in Wellington I am quite certain that she had
a hidden topmast. (Not pde) In Pickett I think

Roapani motor launch. Joe Jukes for T & P Department. Spent most
of her life on Lake Waitaremoana. Kenneth Mengies
bought her to Wellington where he keeps her in chaffers

Began as a shallow dr. Centre Bldg. Dr Napier. Came to
Wgtn circ 1895. Built between Rogue & little Thelma. (Built for
Dre for demolition 1944. Now believed to be in Port Chalmers.
Can recon.

Ethel. ① Was she ever in Wgtn?

Hoia Very commercial. I don't think that NW Thomas ever bought her
to Wellington. Wrecked. New Cal.

Ilex. Logan Bros. Modified by A.W. Burns for ocean passages by
(North) NW Thomas. Stopped in first Sydney Hubert. Crossed
NZ Coast. Sailed to Tonga Registry. Wrecked on Minerva Reef.
Capt & son feared strangled by Toi Toi. son drowned on arrival.

Iorangi Built for A.H. Turnbull to compete with Rainbow & Wandungu etc.

Isca. Have possibly a tracing of her lines. Photo in Carter.
Dixon Kemp design?

Jessie Logan. Well described in Classic.

Kotiri ② Longer than 30ft maybe 34/35. Definitely not a sister of Maunahi.
Understood that both vessels were the result of a Pub wager.
Maunahi built somewhere between the Old Guide Quay Pub and
the fire station. Believed to be in Sydney in good condition.

Mana. Have a photo. Damaged in Chaffers passage. Repaired there.
Built for J.F. Coll. Still exists in Lyttelton. Under restoration in
Burdan Wild. Lona Maddox may have more history

Maritana. A very early vessel to Wellington. Later cunningly reduced
in draught and traded in Tas Bay as a scow/coaster.
See Blind Bay Hookers (Fred Westrup) Two very nice photos of
Maritana. Pages 108 - 132 - 212.

Maranui. Built by Coleman & Scarret in Wgtn mid 1900 may be
just pre 1939.

Nereides. I do not think that Arthur Holmes owned her. Think she was
built for Mitchel an architect. Wider than Vagabond.
Other owners Barrett/Bloxham. L.V. Martin. Barry Cooze.

Nomad. ① Possibly. Seabird's were Mower/Day designs

Nomad. ② There was still is? I believe a Nomad approx 26ft. very wide. Based on an American cat boat. (Mower design)
She sailed in the 50s. Owned by Owen Goddard.

Psyche 614 Jackson had her built. Cutter sometime Ketch others.
