Sail hard and fair, but don't forget that the rights of others do not cease with the finishing gun; and in particular, may we be pardoned if we point out that the wilds of Paremata are changing to the responsibilities of suburbia - so play fair ashore too.

### INFORMATION FOR COMPETITORS

Entries: All skippers must register and pay entrance fee at the Clubbouse by 9 a.m. on Friday morning.

The following entrance fees will be charged to cover all Regatta races except W.P.Y. and M.B. Assn. races:-

XYTR Class: £1. Z Class: 10/-I Class: £1. Frostbites: 7/6 P Class: 2/-

All boats will be classified as belonging to the class in which they first compete.

All boats must race under their class specifications. Handicap limite are as follows:--

XYTR Class: 10 minutes Z Class: 15 minutes
I Class: 15 minutes Frostbites: 20 minutes
P Class: 15 minutes

The above limits will not apply to Monday's races.

Crews are limited as follows:-

XYT Class:	3 or 4	Z Class:	2
R Class:	2	Frostbites:	2
I Class:	2 or 3	P Class:	1

Sail area of XYT Class limited to 250 square feet carried on the wind. All sails to be measured on the spars. Spinnaker boom limited to 12 feet 6 inches.

Conditions of races: 3 starters or no race; 4 starters or no second prize; 5 starters or no third prize; 6 starters or no 4th prize.

Handicap Events - Mark Foy Starts:- A number will be shown for one minute on starting frame for each competitor before finally away. In the event of a boat gaining an unfair start her number will be re-hoisted until she re-crosses the starting line. Class letters will not be shown on the starting numbers. Classes will be indicated by coloured flags, as under:-

XYTR Class: Orange Z Class: Black I Class White Frostbites Green

P Class: Blue

e.g. the numeral "3" with Blue flag, represents "P3".

Flying Starts:- Numbers 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 will be shown on starting frame, or 5 flags afloat, and will be lowered at one minute intervals, starting with 5 and working backwards. Any boat away

before the fall of the last numeral will have her classification number hoisted and will then have to return and re-cross the starting line before the starter will lower her number.

All boats must be afloat when the number of the limit boat of their class is hoisted, and no change of crew may be made

after that signal.

All boats in handicap events are under the control of the Starter and the Judges when the number of the limit boat is hoisted, or, in a scratch race, when the 5 one minute flags are hoisted.

Skippers are asked to keep their boats clear of the Clubhouse when races are being started to allow competitors a clear view

of the starting numbers.

Changes of Skippers <u>must</u> be notified to either the Handicapper or Regatta Secretary half an hour before the start of the race.

The finish of races will be acknowledged by the Judge on the finishing line by the report of a gun or whistle. Until you hear the signal, keep going, and if you think you are not credited with finishing, signal the Judge of the fact.

The Regatta races will be sailed under I.Y.R.U. rules, except where modified by the rules of the Paremata Boating Club and this

programme.

All protests to be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the finish of the protesting boat. A fee of 5/- to be lodged with the protest. The fee may be retained by the Club if the protest is considered of a frivolous nature.

Time limit for Regatta races is three hours.

The Club reserves the right to substitute for cash prizes

any trophies donated after the programme has gone to press.

It is a condition of entry that the decision of the Paremata Boating Club shall be accepted as final in regard to the distribution of its own trophies and prize money.

All boats must carry their correct classification number unless they have the permission of the starter to carry another number.

Visiting boats from outside Wellington should, if possible, carry their port's distinguishing letter.

I Class: The I Class races will be run in two divisions if there are 35 or more entries. If entries fall short of 35, the I Class races will be run in one division at programme times as for "North Division", and prize money will be increased as follows:-

1st £2: 2nd £1: 3rd 15/-: 4th 10/-: 5th 7/6: 6th 5/-.

Should the entries fall short of 25, the prize money will be:
1st £1: 2nd 15/-: 3rd 10/-: 4th 5/-.

R Class: R Class boats have been programmed to race with the XYT Class. However, should there be 6 or more R Class entries, the Club reserves the right to transfer them to separate R Class races, and to establish a scale of prize money therefor.

## JOSEPHINE BRADEY CUP, SAN TOY CUP, QUIRKE PLAQUE AND ROSS TROPHY

The race for the Duncan Cup is for Takapuna Class boats only, and the skippers and crews must be under 21 years of age on 1st February.

The Monotype Championship is also open only to Takapuna

Class boats, but there is no age restriction.

For each of the above races one shilling (1/-) entrance fee will be charged. Entries must be in the hands of the Secretary of the Paremata Boating Club by 9 a.m., Easter Friday. Crews must be nominated.

Entrance fees for these races are a W.P.Y. and M.B. Association charge.


