#### -> DIRECTIONS. -

The starting and finishing line shall be an imaginary line drawn between S.E. corner, Queen's Wharf and Destructor Chimney

#### No. 1 Course is-

From starting line at Queen's Wharf, thence to and round Club buoy off Koro Koro, thence to and round buoy off Pinnacle Rock, thence to and across starting line. Yachts must keep on town side of Somes' and Ward's Islands. Reverse course in northerly winds.

#### No. 2 COURSE IS-

From starting line at Queen's Wharf, thence to and round Club buoy off Koro Koro, thence to and round buoy off Hope Shoal (Ward Island), thence to and across starting line. Yachts must keep on town side of Somes' and Ward's Islands. Reverse course in northerly winds.

#### No. 3 COURSE IS-

From starting line at Queen's Wharf, thence to and round Club buoy off Koro Koro, thence to and round buoy off Point Halswe: I, thence to and across starting line. Yachts must keep on town side of Somes' and Ward's Islands. Reverse course in northerly winds.

#### STARTING OF SECOND RACES.

If all the boats in the first race of any class are not across the finishing line before the starting time of the second race, it shall be optional for the sub-committee of the day to start or postpone the race.

For all sailing races in N. winds, the buoys used to mark the course are to be kept on the port side, and in S. winds on

the starboard side of yacht when rounding.

In the event of a shift in the wina, boats will keep the

course on which they start.

For all events three to start or no second prize, subject to Rule 28.

In all races boats to cross finishing line not later than 7 p.m.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR STARTING

For each race Blue Peter will be hoisted and gun fired as a time signal five minutes before starting time of first boat, and Blue Peter will be lowered when five minutes have expired. Each Yacht will be allotted a flag, to be hoisted on wharf five minutes before starting time of such yacht, when time is up her flag will be lowered as a signal to start; should, however, any yacht be over the starting line before the time, her flag will be kept up as a recall signal, and will be lowered as a signal to start after such yacht has recrossed the starting line.

Letter N of the Commercial Code, hoisted on Thorndon Yacht Shed, shall be the signal that all races have been

postponed.

Handicaps for first race for Third Class Yachts will be declared at 9 a.m., and Handicaps for all classes second race will be declared at 1 p.m.

All handicaps will be posted up at Thorndon Yacht Club

shed, and a copy handed to starter on Queen's Wharf.
