To start at 10.30 a.m. Once round No. 1 Course. Open to all Yachts of 36ft. L.R. and over.

No. 2. Second-Class Yachts (Rating).

To start at 10.45 a.m. Twice round No. 2 Course. Open to all Yachts over 25ft. L.R. and under 36ft. L.R. Prizes—First, £5; second, £2 10s.

No. 3. Third Class Yachts (Handicap).

To start at 11 a.m. Twice round No. 2 Course. Open to all Yachts under 25ft. L.R.

Prizes-First, £5; second, £2 10s; third, £1.

No. 4.—Patiki Class (Half-decked Boats over 14ft.) Handicap.

To start at 11.15 a.m. Twice round No 2 Course.



DIRECTIONS.



The starting and finishing line shall be an imaginary line drawn

between Flagship and shore near Patent Slip.

No. I COURSE is from starting line to buoy off Koro Koro, leaving same on starboard hand and back to Flagship if North wind. N.B.—

Reverse course if South wind.

No. 2 COURSE is from starting line to and round buoy off Point Jerningham, leaving same on starboard hand, thence to and round buoy off Point Halswell, leaving same on starboard hand, and round the Flagship, leaving same on starboard hand if North wind. N.B.—Reverse course if South wind.

No. 3 COURSE is from starting line thence to and round mark at the head of Evans' Bay, leaving same on starboard hand (due South from Flagship), and back to Flagship.

In all races three to start or no second prize, five to start or no third

prize, subject to rule 28.

STARTING OF SECOND RACES.

If all the boats in the first race of any class are not across the finishing line before the starting time of the second race, it shall be optional for the sub-committee of the day to start or postpone the race.

In the event of a shift in the wind, boats will keep the course on

which thep start.

In all races boats to cross finishing line not later than 7 p.m.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR STARTING.

For each race Blue Peter will be hoisted and gun fired as a time signal five minutes before starting time of first boat, and Blue Peter will be lowered when five minutes have expired. Each yacht will be allotted a flag, to be hoisted on Flagship five minutes before starting time of such yacht; when time is up her flag will be lowered as a signal to start. Should, however, any yacht be over the starting line before the time her flag will be kept up as a recall signal, and will be lowered as a signal to start after such yacht has recrossed the starting line.

Letter N of the Commercial Code, hoisted on Thorndon Yacht Club

Shed, shall be the signal that all races have been postponed.

All handicaps will be posted on Flagship, and a copy handed to the starter.

ENTRANCE FEES.

For First, Second, and Third-class Yachts and Launches, 5% of the total prize money.

For Patikis, Open Boats (10ft. and under), Half-Decked Boats (14ft.

and under), 2/6 each race.

For Ships' Boats, Coal Hulks' Boats, and Naval Cutters, FREE.

Entries close with the Secretary, at the Thorndon Yacht Club Shed, on Thursday, 18th January, 1906, at 8 p.m.
