PRELIMINARY PROGRAMME.

1. Handicap Yacht Race. For any yachts not entering for First and Second-class Yacht Races.—First prize, £ ; second, £ . Twice round No. 2 (new) course. To start at 10.15 a.m.
2. Ten or Twelve-oar Cutter Race. Open to Naval Artillery or Torpedo Corps, or Men-of-War (handicap).—First prize, £ . Post entries. To start at 10.30 a.m.
3. Second-class Sailing Race, 14ft.—Prize, £ . Twice round No. 3 course. To start at 10.45 a.m.
4. First-class Yacht Race. For classified Yachts, 5 tons rating and over.—First prize, £ ; second, £ . Twice round No. 1 Course. To start at 11 a.m.
5. Second-class Yacht Race. For classified Yachts, 2½ tons rating and under 5 tons rating.—First prize, £ ; second, £ . Twice round No. 2 (new) Course. To start at 11.15 a.m.
6. Third-class Yacht Race. For all Yachts under 2½ rating.—Prizes, £ and £ . Three to start or no race. Once round No. 2 (new) Course. To start at 11.30 a.m.
7. Ships' Boat Race, Four Oars.—Prizes £ and £ . Post entries. Once round No. 4 Course. To start 11.45 a.m.
8. Open Boat Sailing Race, 18ft.—Prizes, £ and £ . Twice round No. 3 Course. One minute per foot handicap. To start at 12 noon.
9. Sailing Naval Cutter Race.—Prizes, £ Under conditions to be arranged by officers appointed as handicappers in Naval and Man-o'-War Races. Twice round No. 3 Course. To start at 12.30 p.m.
10. Model Yacht Race (three classes).—Prizes, £ in each. Entrance free. Under the auspices of the Model Yacht Club. To start at 2 p.m.
